


Parents and Teachers are crucial factors determining whether gifts develop into talents.


TALENTED **LEARNER**



- Gets along well with classmates


2. LEARNING PROGRESS

- 70% (Overall) in examinable subjects (EL, MA, SCI, MT) as an **indicator** of whether a student is coping in the GEP.
- Teachers use **multiple data points** to assess if students can meet this 'benchmark', e.g. Weighted & Non-Weighted Assessments, daily work, learning attitude, etc.

3. OVERALL CONDUCT

- Displays good conduct consistently
- Based on school's Conduct Grade

The purpose of <u>all</u> forms of assessment is to identify learning gaps and bridge them through feedback.


Weighted Assessments:


- Standardized across 9 GEP centres for English,
 Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies.
- School-based assessment for Mother Tongue.
- Projects, assignments, performance tasks, etc.

Non-Weighted Assessments:

 Scores are not counted toward overall results in a subject but are **important components** in the curriculum.
